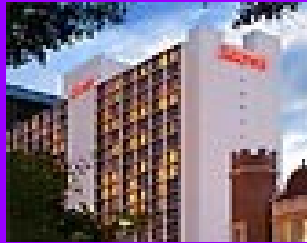

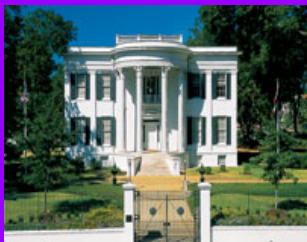

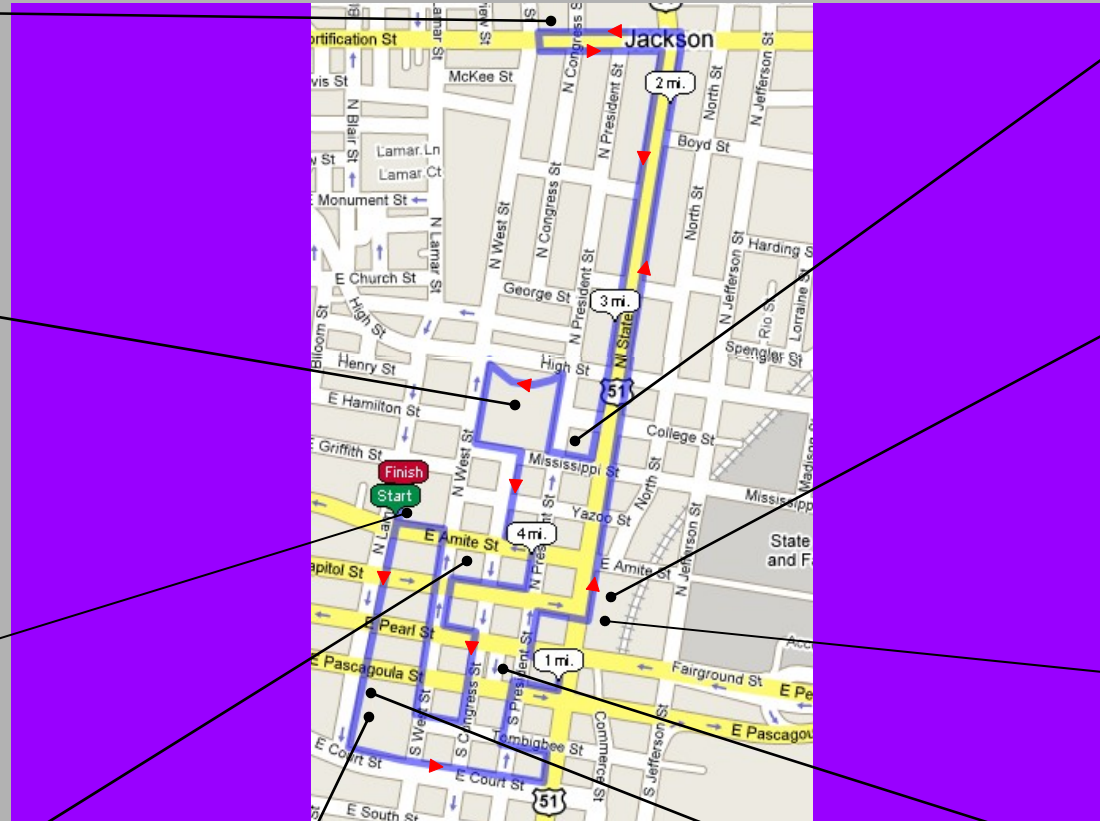

JACKSON WALK DIRECTIONS

February 13, 2008

1. Exit the Marriott Hotel on to E Amite St. and turn Right and proceed to N Lamar St.
2. Turn Left on N Lamar St. and proceed to E Court St. (follow the red arrows on the map).
P.O.I. = Davis Planetarium on left past E Pascagoula St.
P.O.I. = Mississippi Museum of Art on left
3. Turn Left on E Court St. and proceed to S State St.
4. Turn Left S State St. and proceed to Tombigbee St
5. Turn Left on Tombigbee St and proceed to S President St.
6. Cross S President St. and turn Right and cross Tombigbee St and proceed straight on S President St. to E. Pascagoula St.
7. Cross E Pascagoula St. then immediately turn Right and proceed straight on E Pascagoula St. to S State St.
P.O.I. = Jackson City Hall on left at corner of S President St. and E Pascagoula St.
8. Turn Left on S State St. and proceed to E Pearl St.
9. Turn Left on E Pearl St. and proceed to S President St.
10. Turn Right on S President St. and proceed to E Capitol St.
11. Turn Right on E Capitol St. and proceed to S State St.
12. Cross S State St. and turn Left on State St.
P.O.I. = Old Capitol Building in right
P.O.I. = War Memorial on right after Old Capitol Building
13. Continue straight on S State St. as it turns into N State St. and proceed to E Fortification St. **
14. Cross E Fortification St. and turn Left on E Fortification St. and proceed to N West St.
P.O.I. = Manship House Museum on right past N Congress St.
15. Turn Left and cross E Fortification St. and then immediately turn Left and proceed straight on E Fortification St. to N State St.
16. Turn Right on N State St. and proceed to Mississippi St.
P.O.I. = Municipal Art Gallery on right after College St.
17. Turn Right on Mississippi St. and proceed to N President St.
18. Cross N President St. and then turn Right on N President St. and proceed to High St.
19. Turn Left on High St. and veer to the Left and follow the circular drive in front of the Capitol Building proceeding around to the corner of High St. and N West St.
P.O.I. = Mississippi Capitol Building on left
20. Turn Left on N West St. and proceed to Mississippi St.
21. Turn Left on Mississippi St. and proceed to N Congress St. (street perpendicular to the South entrance of the Capitol Building).
22. Turn Right and cross Mississippi St. and proceed straight on N Congress St. to E Amite St.
23. Turn Left on E Amite St. and proceed to N President St.
24. Turn Right on N President St. and proceed to E Capitol St.
25. Turn Right on E Capitol St. and proceed to N West St.
P.O.I. = Governor's Mansion on right after N Congress St.
26. Turn Left on N West St. and proceed to E Pearl St.
27. Turn Left on E Pearl St. and proceed to S Congress St.
28. Turn Right on S Congress St. and proceed to Tombigbee St.
29. Turn Right on Tombigbee St. and proceed to S West St.
30. Turn Right on S West St. and proceed to E Amite St..
31. Cross E Amite St. and turn Left on E Amite St. and proceed to N Lamar St. and the Marriott Hotel.

** If you can only commit to 2.5 miles or so, turn Left on High St. and then Left on N Lamar St. and proceed back to the Marriott Hotel at E Amite St.
