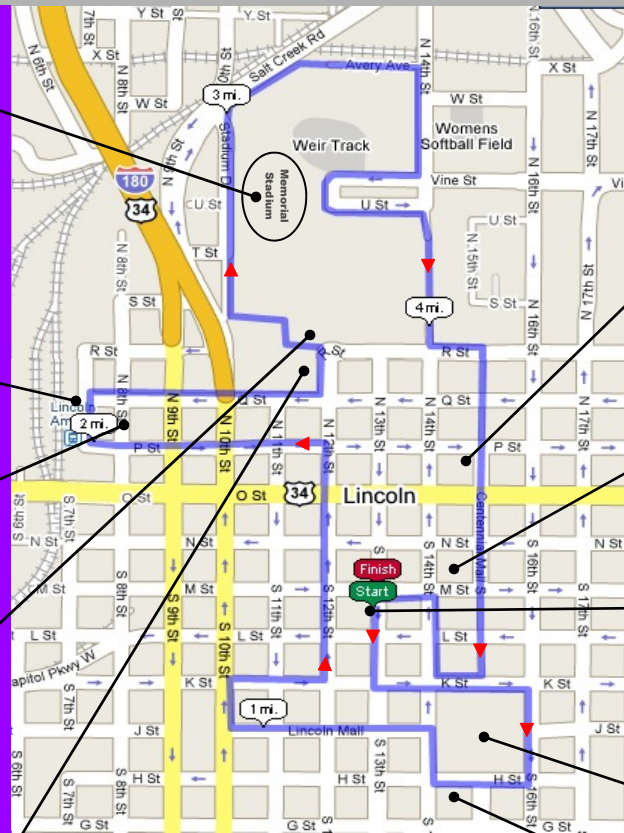

LINCOLN WALK DIRECTIONS

October 23, 2007

1. Exit The Cornhusker Hotel on to S 13th St. and turn Right and proceed to K St. (follow the Red arrows on the map).
2. Cross K St. and turn Left on K St and proceed to S 16th St.
P.O.I. Nebraska State Capitol Building on the right
3. Turn Right on S 16th St and proceed to H St.
4. Cross H St. and turn Right on H St. and proceed to S 14th St.
P.O.I. = Governors Mansion on left prior to S 14th St.
5. Turn Right on S 14th St. and proceed to Lincoln Mall.
6. Turn Left on Lincoln Mall and proceed to S 10th St.
7. Turn Right on S 10th St. and proceed to K St.
8. Turn Right on K St. and proceed to S 12th St.
9. Turn Left on S 12th St. and proceed to P St.
10. Turn Left on P St. and proceed to N 7th St.
P.O.I. = Historic Haymarket District after N 9th St.
11. Turn Right on N 7th St. and proceed to Q St.
P.O.I. = Iron Horse Park on left at Q St.
12. Turn Right on Q St. and proceed to N 12th St. **
13. Turn Left on N 12th St. and proceed to R St.
P.O.I. = Lied Center for the Performing Arts on left prior to R St.
14. Turn Left at R St. and proceed straight on to the walkway entering the University of Nebraska campus.
P.O.I. = Sheldon Memorial Art Gallery and Sculpture Garden on right
15. Turn Right on the walkway into the Sheldon Sculpture Garden and proceed through the garden to the Woods Art Building
16. Turn Left on the walkway in front of the Woods Art Building and proceed on the walkway between the Brace Laboratory building on the right and Architecture Hall on the left to Stadium Dr.
17. Turn Right on Stadium Dr. and proceed past Memorial Stadium and the Champion's Club to the walkway prior to Salt Creek Rd.
P.O.I. = University of Nebraska at Lincoln Memorial Stadium on right
18. Turn Right on the walkway at Salt Creek Rd. and proceed to the Hawks Champion Center.
19. Turn Right on the walkway past the Hawks Champion Center and proceed to N 14th St.
20. Turn Right on N 14th St. and proceed to Vine St.
21. Turn Right on Vine St. and proceed in a U, comprised of Vine St., Left on N 12th St (parallels the west entrance to Memorial Stadium), Left on the walkway leading back to N 14th St (Mueller Tower will be on your right).
22. Turn Right on N 14th St. and proceed straight on the road/walkway through campus to R St.
23. Turn Left on R St. and proceed past the Nebraska Union to the Nebraska State Historical Society building.
24. Turn Right at the Nebraska State Historical Society building and cross R St and proceed on to Centennial Mall N.
25. Proceed straight on Centennial Mall N to K St.
P.O.I. = Museum of Nebraska History on right after P St.
P.O.I. = Lincoln Community Foundation Garden on right after N St.
26. Turn Right at K St. and proceed to S 14th St.
27. Turn Right on S 14th St. and proceed to M St.
28. Turn Left on M St. and proceed to S 13th St.
29. Cross S 13th St. and turn Left and proceed back to The Cornhusker Hotel.

** If you can only commit to 3 miles or so, instead of turning Left on N 12th St., continue to N 13th St. and turn Right on N 13th St. and proceed back to the Cornhusker Hotel.
