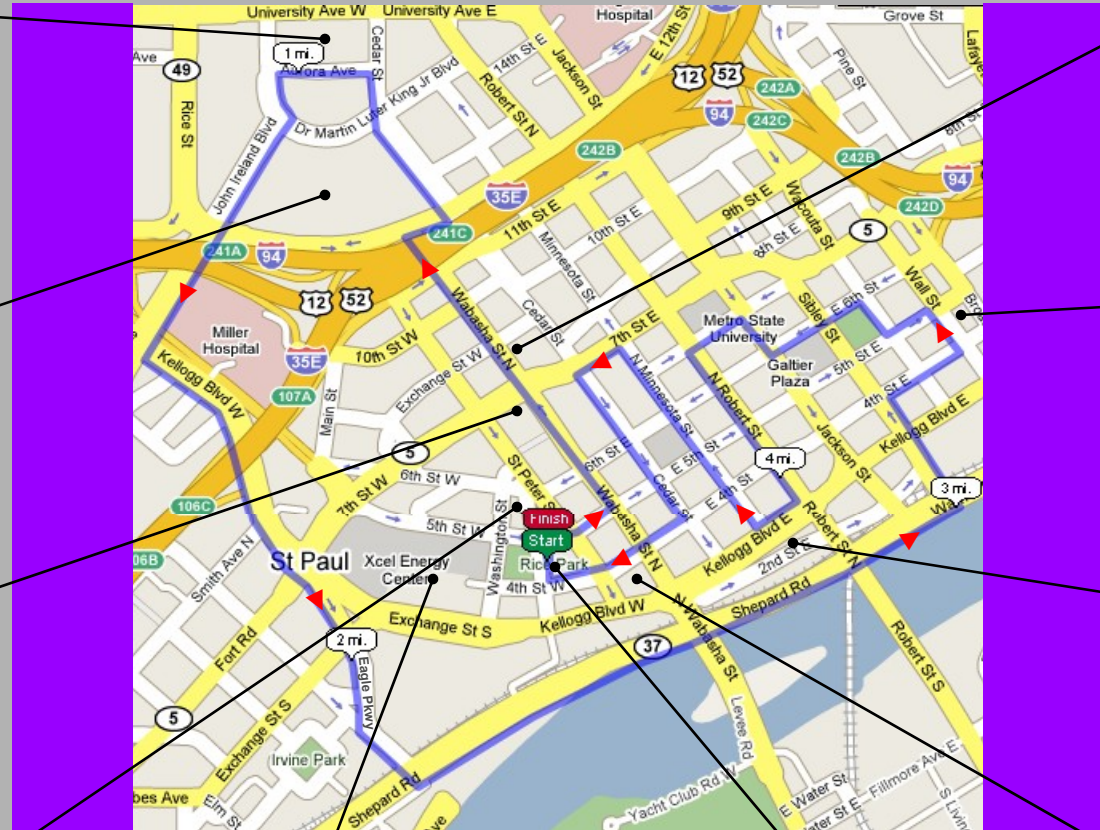

## ST. PAUL WALK DIRECTIONS

September 12, 2007

1. Exit the St. Paul Hotel to Market St. (follow the Red arrows on the map).
2. Turn Right on Market St. and proceed to 5<sup>th</sup> St. W.
3. Turn Right on 5<sup>th</sup> St. W and proceed to Wabasha St. N.  
P.O.I. = Landmark Center on left
4. Turn Left on Wabasha St. N. and proceed to 12<sup>th</sup> St. E (W 12<sup>th</sup> St. starts to the left).  
P.O.I. = Children's Museum on left prior to 7<sup>th</sup> St. W  
P.O.I. = Fitzgerald Theater (Prairie Home Companion) on the right prior to Exchange St. W.
5. Turn Right on 12<sup>th</sup> St. E and proceed to Cedar St. (Cedar St. not marked, St. Paul Armory on the NE corner of 12<sup>th</sup> St. E and Cedar St.).
6. Cross Cedar St. and proceed straight on Cedar St. to Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd.  
P.O.I. = Minnesota War Memorials on left prior to Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd.
7. Cross Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. and continue on Cedar St. to Aurora Ave. (road in front of Capitol Building).
8. Turn Left on Aurora Ave. and proceed to Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd.  
P.O.I. = Minnesota State Capitol Building on the right
9. Turn Left on Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. and proceed to the crosswalk just past John Ireland Blvd.
10. Cross Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. and proceed straight (S) on the pathway that parallels the east side of John Ireland Blvd. till it ends at W 12<sup>th</sup> St.
11. Cross W 12<sup>th</sup> St. and continue straight on John Ireland Blvd. to Kellogg Blvd. W.
12. Cross Kellogg Blvd. W and turn Left on Kellogg Blvd. W and proceed to Fort Rd. (7<sup>th</sup> St. W to the left). \*\*
13. Cross Fort Rd. and continue Straight on Kellogg Blvd. W and then bear Right on to Eagle St. (becomes Eagle Parkway).  
P.O.I. = Xcel Energy Center on the left
14. Continue straight on Eagle Parkway till it ends at Shepard Rd. (Spring St. to the right) cross Shepard Rd. and turn Left onto the pathway between Shepard Rd. and the Mississippi River.
15. Continue straight on the pathway and proceed to Sibley St.
16. Turn Left on Sibley St. and proceed to 4<sup>th</sup> St. E.
17. Turn Right on 4<sup>th</sup> St. E and proceed to Wall St.
18. Turn Left on Wall St. and proceed to 5<sup>th</sup> St. E.  
P.O.I. = Farmers' Market on the right.
19. Turn Left on 5<sup>th</sup> St. E and proceed to Wacouta St.
20. Turn Right on Wacouta St. and proceed to 6<sup>th</sup> St. E.
21. Turn Left on 6<sup>th</sup> St. E and proceed to Jackson St.
22. Turn Right on Jackson St. and proceed to 7<sup>th</sup> Pl. E.
23. Turn Left on 7<sup>th</sup> Pl. E and proceed to Robert St. N.
24. Cross Robert St. N and turn Left on Robert St. N and proceed to Kellogg Blvd E.
25. Turn Right on Kellogg Blvd E and proceed to Minnesota St.  
P.O.I. = Kellogg Park on the left between the Wabasha St. and Robert St. bridges
26. Turn Right on Minnesota St. and proceed to 7<sup>th</sup> St. E
27. Turn Left on 7<sup>th</sup> St. E and proceed to Cedar St.
28. Turn Left on Cedar St. and proceed to 4<sup>th</sup> St. E.
29. Turn Right on 4<sup>th</sup> St. E and proceed to Market St.  
P.O.I. = Ramsey County Government Center on the left past Wabasha St. N.
30. Turn Right on Market St. and proceed to the St. Paul Hotel.

\*\* If you can only commit to 2.5 miles or so, continue straight on Kellogg St. W to Market St. and turn Left and proceed back to the St. Paul Hotel.
